Please briefly present your organisation	Asociatia Sportiva ROMISCARE is a non-profit organization founded in 2020 with the goal of making sports accessible to all especially to vulnerable children and youth at risk of poverty and marginalization. In order to fulfill its mission Romiscare implements sport based projects designed to promote social inclusion and social cohesion among communities. Romiscare operates through a network of over 130 sport clubs, social care institutions and health care centers The organisation is composed of 7 co-workers employed on a temporary basis under different mobility programmes, and a pool of 40 volunteers. Mission: Romiscare promotes Intercultural Dialogue, Social Entrepreneurship, Social Inclusion through Sport, integration of migrants and environmental protection. Romiscare operates in both the formal and non formal branches of education. Services: Training, Project Design and implementation, Thematic and Desk Research, International Mobility, and Consultancy are the core services of Romiscare at local, regional and European level for public and private bodies. Romiscare promotes and develops European and transcontinental projects – in the above-mentioned sectors Romiscare professionals would like to further develop knowledge and competences in youth/adult/sport workers around the world, on the following areas: – Principles of NFE Sports tools – New teaching methods and tools on education through sport – Sport Management competences Romiscare has displayed a long-standing focus on the use of Sport as a tool of social inclusion, with a specific focus on disadvantaged categories, among whom migrants. We are active in the field of education: - Understanding Diversity Coaching Inclusion - integration solutions for educators and youth workers working with immigrants - Empowerment of women - courses of fast learning of Greek to immigrant mothers and their children - social entrepreneurship - digital communication, digital marketing - inter cultural dialogue for mutual understanding, tolerance and respect - sustainable Ecosystem and recycling - theatrical plays, music and dance ateliers for inclusion - drama therapy workshop - workshops for EUROPASS certificates, CV and language portfolio - active citizenship and volunteering - video production and scenography, overcoming the past and imagine Europe of the future - Art workshop for youngsters from different social backgrounds to come closer in painting a common artwork. Our support services develop and improve the quality of life meeting the needs of our community through voluntary activities. The volunteer members of Romiscare hold a source of knowledge and advice on the importance of social cohesion and change management. We aim to engage and positively influence youth through our educational based programs to equip them with digital, entrepreneurial skills. Most of them are unemployed or have fewer opportunities. We hold meetings with young people from our community and surrounding areas to help in their emotional and social development in an informal setting but through educational processes. We develop supportive relationships for sustainable new experiences to foster increased confidence, ambition and empathy. This prepares them to make a positive contribution to society in adult life.
